

## CITIZEN CONSUMER CLUB REPORT

On 27.12.2021, on the occasion of citizen consumer day, we have organized the field visit to Jewellery shop to aware the students on consuming the Jewellery. Thirty eight students along with the Consumer club coordinators went to Palani Murgan Jewellery shop, it was held by the Chief Guest of our event Dr. K.K. Chokalinkam, State President, Coordination's of Consumer Association, Tamilnadu.

The shop owner welcomed our guest and students kind heartedly and permitted to visit their shop. Our students first visited all the counters which consists of full of golden and diamond jewells. Then all the students gathered in the shop meeting hall and the sales executive of the shop came there and gave a speech on importance of gold and the quality of the gold. Then our chief guest gave awareness speech on ISI and BIS hallmark of gold, hallmarks protect consumers from dishonest jewellery manufacturers. Such unscrupulous producers may reduce the amount of gold contained within the gold alloy used to make the jewellery or use a gold coating over a metal core, tungsten is commonly used for fake gold jewellery, how to check the quality of the gold and explained that gold is a relatively rare metal, prized for its glistening appearance and high value. Then the sales executer branded a diamond Jewell and explained how the karat differentiations between gold and diamond karats and how to select a qualified gold and diamond while purchasing the Jewell and described gold purity can be measured precisely by determining the density of the gold. The accuracy of this measurement also depends upon the accuracy of the jewellery scale or gold scale used to carry out the density determination. They clarified the doubts of the students and they gave the chances to identify the hallmark of the gold and diamond by viewing the gold and diamond Jewell through the identification lenses. Then our college students analysed and clarified their doubts regarding the jewellery consuming. After this, our students gathered in the BIS hallmarking centre, the gold hallmark includes the manufacturer's mark, a 'Common Control Mark' that identifies the precious metal, the gold purity, and the mark of the office that provided the hallmark. The Assaying and Hallmarking Centres undertake the testing of Jewellery, Samples of common consumers on priority on chargeable basis. The Assaying and Hallmarking centre is required to issue Assay Report giving proper identifications as marked on article. The centre executives explained about hallmarking system and procedures that they are following the BIS Hallmarking Scheme has been aligned with International criteria on hallmarking. As per this scheme, Registration is granted to the jewellers by BIS under Hallmarking Scheme. The BIS certified jewellers can get their jewellery hallmarked from any of the BIS recognized Assaying and Hallmarking Centres. By that Consumer can get its jewellery/sample tested from any of the BIS Recognized Assaying & Hallmarking Centre. The Assaying and Hallmarking Centres undertake the testing of Jewellery/Samples of common consumers on priority on chargeable basis. The Assaying and Hallmarking centre is required to issue Assay Report giving proper identifications as marked on article. Then our students clarified their doubts regarding that, then we completely awarded on Jewellery Hallmarking and by thanking our consumer club chief guest and shop owner, we relived from the place with positive one
