


'A foreign language is like a frail, delicate muscle. If you do not use it, it weakens.'

Report

On June 19–20, 2023, we conducted a refresher course for II and III-year students and an induction program for 1-year students on June 26–27, 2023. Initially, a refresher course was organized by the staff members, and the best students were found out from the refresher course to organize the orientation program for first-year students under the staff's guidance. Each activity is planned in such a way that it helps improve student's skills. The activities are grouping, story building, pick and speak, self-narration, craft work, find out things, find out Words, Communication game, form filling, and advertisement. Students were split into groups based on their strengths, and the score for each team is noted. A special score is given to the team that maintains good time management. In between the events, some fun game was conducted. A lecture on smart behavior and emotional intelligence was given by our principal, Dr. N. Nagadeepa, and goal setting was given by Mr. Muthu Ramalingam, ABVP state organizing secretary, and career guidance was given by Mr. K. K. Magudapathi, a former researcher at TNAU. At the end, feedback was received from the students.

Grouping

Since there are fifteen people on each team, they must choose a chit from a pile and sort the people depending on how similar the characters are to those on their team. Finding out about leadership, planning, teamwork, tendencies toward adaptability, volunteerism, and creating new connections with people can all be aided by this.

Craft work

Each team had bought newspapers and supplements on their own. They have to make art out of waste within the given time. It helps them think innovatively. Teamwork, involvement, acceptance, group discussion, and listening to others ideas are the major factors noted in this activity.

Story building

Students had to build the story based on the previous line said by the team member. Finally, the story must be creative and have a moral. The qualities that we found in this among the students are teamwork, grasping quality, concentration, spontaneity, and creativity.

Form filling and Advertisement

Making students learn the basics of how to fill out important forms like railway bookings, bank challans, etc. Advertising in 15 minutes by creating a slogan and a 2-minute advertisement with a brief presentation about the concept given to them helped us find out the imagination skills of students, leadership, and content creation. It helps them overcome stage fear.

Pick and speak

Fifteen different topics related to our heritage were given to the students. They picked a topic from that and gave a speech about it. So that a team learnt about all fifteen topics.

Self-narration

Self-narration was given to students so that they would know themselves, and self-motivation is important for a person. She would know her strengths and weaknesses through this.

Find out things

In a hall, many different things were shattered, and a blindfolded member of a team had to find out things by following instructions given by other members of the team. It improves their concentration, trust, clarity in giving instructions, and coordination.

Find out Words

A word is given to the team with additional letters in a shuffled manner. They have to find the word by eliminating the additional letters. It creates the opportunity to learn new vocabulary, improves thinking capacity. It creates eagerness.

Communication Game

A communication game is conducted to improve understanding and concentration. A proverb is given to the first member of a team. She had to explain the proverb to the second member by acting to describe it. Finally, the last member has to explain the proverb. It helps to find out the acting skill.
